New CD ROM Sets to release following the Holiday Season.

RB Series Economical Rotary Blister Packaging Machines updated.



The RB Series Economical Rotary Blister Packaging machines underwent a controls update, safety upgrade and a minor sheet metal change in the fourth quarter.

The knob and dial interface with the PLC has been replaced with a small LCD HMI. This has allowed us to make the cycle counter standard and add an auto cycle mode. The machine has safety swing gates. The sheet metal change allows easier access to the machine internal components for servicing.

The RB Series machines are the logical next step beyond a shuttle machine. The additional open loading stations combined with a system that is machine paced rather than operator paced add up to improved productivity and greater finished package throughput.

Recently we have seen a number of these machines purchased to replace Visual DS series machines that are now between 20 and 35 years old and no longer serviceable. Tooling from the DS machines drops directly into our same size sealing area RB Series machines. We have also provided the RB6 model with a slight modification to replace the Hoover brand six-station rotaries and utilize the existing tooling.

Two models of the RB Series machines are offered. The RB4-1418 four-station with a 14" x 18" sealing area as shown above and the RB6-1214 six-station with a 12" x 14" sealing area.
